

# Decentralization in Romania

**Abstract:** In the last decade Romania made important steps in developing a scheme for financial decentralisation, but the implementation of this policy met with difficulties due to the absence of a national strategy for decentralisation. There were three cycles in the process: 1991-1994, 1998-2000 and 2001 – till now. Those cycles will be presented in this proceeding.

Also, a proper answer to the problems of decentralisation and deconcentration of Romania's system of public administration was formulated within the framework of the actualized strategy concerning the acceleration of public administration reform.
